Your questions answered

How many people can join each course?

Each course has a maximum of 15 participants to ensure a high-quality learning experience

Will I receive a certificate?

Yes. Upon completion of the course you will receive a certification and when you complete the assessment, you will receive a certificate of successful completion.

Do I need to take a refresher course every year?

No. These courses are developed to ensure that participants are supported in the delivery of their role. Courses are updated regularly and when required. Courses are voluntary, and therefore a one off unless you choose to refresh your knowledge.

Will this course help with my APS Membership application?

Yes. Completing this course will earn you 2 points towards your APS Membership application. A maximum of 2 points per application can be obtained.

Is the course assessed?

Yes. Each course includes a timed assessment at the end to validate your understanding of the material.

What happens if the course is full?

We operate a waiting list system. If a course is fully booked, you'll be added to the list and notified if a space becomes available. The course will be run more than once at intervals across the year.

Has the course been accredited?

Yes. Each course has been peer-reviewed and is CPD certified, ensuring quality and relevance.



Is the course delivered online or in person?

Courses are delivered online via live sessions to allow for interaction with tutors and peers. The course will not be recorded so you must attend live.

Can I attend but have my camera off?

Active participation is required, so keeping your camera on will be necessary.

How much does the course cost?
